- 2024 study assessed **impact of EU copyright and data laws** on research access



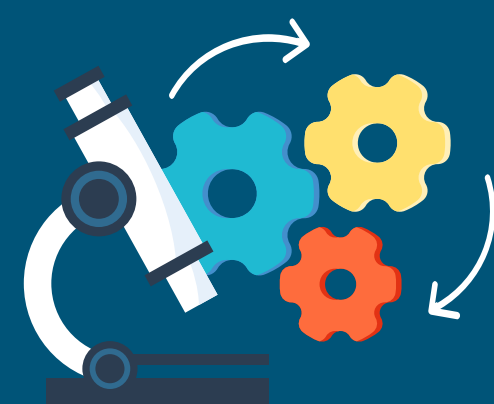
##### RESEARCH CAREERS & MOBILITY
